Trick or Treat Goody Card designed by JudiKins

Materials and Tools:

- Deco Art®
 - Americana Chalk - Pale Yellow?
- JudiKins
 - Color Sponges
 - Ultra Cream cardstock - postcard size
 - Rubber stamps
 - Trick-or-Treat
 - Parisian Gate
 - Pigment Ink pad
 - Embossing Powder
 - Detail Black
- Embossing Heat tool
- Mica Gloss
 - Gold
 - Candy Apple Red
- Folded Square Notecard
- Orange cardstock
- Sizzix
 - Thinlits
 - Pocket Card
 - Geo Tags
 - Ruler
 - Stylus
 - JudiKins Rubber Stamps
 - Who's There Eyes
 - Coil of Strings,
 - Beacon Paper adhesive
 - Makin Air Dry Clay

Instructions:

Folded card -

1. Apply the yellow Chalk paint over the surface of cream card stock with a Color Sponge. Let dry.
2. Blot off excess paint from Color Sponge and apply Mica Gloss Gold to the surface of the sponge.
3. Apply a small amount of Candy Apple Red Mica Gloss into the center of the sponge. Tap off excess and twist onto yellow painted card stock in a checker board pattern. Let dry.
4. Stamp Trick-or-Treat image with pigment ink and emboss with Black Detail embossing powder.
5. Layer onto Orange folded card. Set aside.

Tag Card -

1. Using the Rectangle Tag cutting die, cut out with the Sizzix Big Shot.
2. Stamp the bottom third of the tag with the "Who's There Eyes" rubber stamp with black ink.
3. Stamp "Coil of Strings" in the center of the upper edge of the tag. Set aside

Bat Embellishment -

1. Roll out a small amount of black Makin's Air Dry Clay to approximately 1/8 inch thick.
2. Ink Bat image stamp with Prussian Blue Mica Gloss and stamp onto rolled out clay. Let dry.
3. Highlight bat's eyes with Deco Arts Americana Chalk paint in white.
4. Adhere Bat to Tag Card.

Tag Pocket -

1. Cut out orange cardstock with Pocket die.
2. Stamp Parisian Gates image with black ink onto front of pocket.
3. Score the side tabs with bone folder and ruler, approximately 1/8 inch from edges of tabs.
4. Create two scored lines on the front and back panels of the pocket 1/8 inch above the bottom fold line.
5. Fold tabs so they create a gusset for the pocket. This will provide space for the candy surprise.

Complete the card by adhering pocket to the front of the folded card.
