### Winter Pocket Scarf

#### Supplies:

- 1/3 yard Eco-fi Plus™ Felt Charcoal, Kunin Group
- 2-9"x12" Craftcuts Printzfelt™ Brown Leopard, Kunin Group
- SoSoft® Fabric Paint Black, DecoArt
- The No Bake Polymer Clay® White, Makin's Clay®
- Push Mold Floral, Makin's Clay®
- Etching Creme, Etchall®
- Fabri-tac® Glue, Beacon Adhesives
- Scissors, Westcott Brand
- Brush
- Measuring Tape
- Ruler
- Black Marker
- Paper
- Chalk
- Pins
- Clip
- Small stencil or die cut
- 6" square vinyl paper
- Mirror Compact

#### Directions:

1. Cut 11" by 44" piece from Charcoal felt. Fold in half. Draw curve on one end with chalk. Cut curve through both layers.

2. Beginning at one end cut a 3" fringe along the straight edge. Use length of scissor blade as guide.
3. Draw a 1 ½" by 4 ½" petal shape and 2" circle on paper, cut out.
4. Fold Leopard felt sheet in half lengthwise, pin ends. Draw four petal shapes and one circle on felt with Sharpie. Cut out through both layers for eight petals and two circles.
5. Fold end of each petal in half wrong sides together. Insert small amount of glue. Press together and hold with clip. Repeat for all petals. Glue circles wrong sides together.
6. Assemble flower by placing circle flat. Arrange petals around circle and glue.
7. Cut a 3 ½" by 4" pocket from Leopard felt. Mark in 1", 1/2" from 4" sides and ¼" from 3 ½" sides. Fold and glue on all three sides leaving the 1" end until last.
8. Glue pocket to inside of scarf leaving end open.
9. Make flower center using a small amount of the clay pushed into the Floral Sunflower Push Mold. Make two flowers.
10. Paint flowers with black fabric paint. It gives a leather look to the flower. Let dry. Glue a clay flower to center of felt flower.
11. Cut a small stencil or use a die cut to fit a 3" compact mirror from contact vinyl. Use reverse or inner image of bird or any image you would like. Adhere to center of glass of compact.
12. Apply etching crème with brush. Wait 15 minutes. Return excess crème to jar. Wash under warm water. Remove vinyl. Dry.
13. Glue second clay flower to top of compact. Insert in pocket.
