## Tropical Fishing Game

### **Materials:**

- Lazy Susan
- Water Patterned Paper
- Makin's Clay®
  - Assorted Colors
  - Ultimate Clay Machine™
- Loew-Cornell™ Simply Art™ paintbrushes
  - Woodsies™ Square Dowels
- DecoArt® Americana® Multi-Surface Satin™ paint - assorted tropical colors
- JudiKins™ Hawaiian Cube
- Sizzix®
  - Big Shot™
- Bigz Die - Leaves by Eileen Hull®
- Bigz Alphabet Set - Fresh Blossoms by Stephanie Ackerman Designs®
- Beacon Adhesives™
  - Tacky Glue
  - 3-in-1 Adhesive
- Magnum Magnetics™ magnetic sheets
- Scissors
- Drill with fine drill bit
- Embroidery floss
- Flat head nails
- Ink pads

**Instructions:**

1. Cut water patterned paper and glue onto top center of Lazy Susan.
2. Drill small hole in one end of square dowels. Add floss, knotting one end, allowing other to extend for fishing line.
3. Paint stripe approximately 1/4" in diameter about 1 1/2" from opposite end of each dowel with assorted colors DecoArt Americana Multi-Surface Satin paints (each person's pole will have a different colored stripe).
4. Stamp area beneath stripe with JudiKins Hawaiian Cube stamp using coordinating ink pads.
5. For "hook", wrap floss around flat head nail, glue in place with 3-in-1 Adhesive.
6. Roll assorted colors Makin's Clay using Ultimate Clay Machine to setting #3 (approximately 1/8". Let dry 24 hours.
7. Die cut using Sizzix Big Shot, Eileen Hull leaves leaves die to create fish and Fresh Blossoms alphabet to cut out ALOHA.
8. Glue small pieces of magnet to each clay piece with 3-in-1 Adhesive.
