Recycling a vintage train case, Ana creates a charming wedding keepsake.

## Supplies:

### Beacon Adhesives

- Felt Glue
- Fabri-Tac
- 3 in 1

### DecoArt

- Decoupage
  - Regular
  - Vintage
- Chalky Finish Paint
  - Lace
- Brown Wax Finish

### Kunin

- Shaggy Felt
- Embossed Felt

### Makin's USA

- Clay
  - Red
  - Terracotta
- Flower Push Mold

- Etching crème

- Photo of Bride & Groom
- State Map
- Lace Trim (optional)
- Batting
- Cardboard

## **DIRECTIONS**

1. Clean vintage train case
2. Make a paper template of the inside of the lid (note: the lid and inside bottom should be the same size)
3. Cut 2 pieces of cardboard
4. Decoupage a map of the state the couple lives in or getting married
5. Make two red hearts from clay, glue on the spot the couple lives and is getting married, set aside to dry
6. Cover the other piece of cardboard cover with a batting, glue down
7. Cut felt a little larger than the cardboard, clip and glue the edges to the bottom of the cardboard, set aside to dry
8. Cut piece of felt to go over the edge where the lid and case meet, glue in place
9. Measure from the inside edge of the case to the bottom, cut strip of felt, sew cotton lace around edge, glue to inside wall of case
10. Repeat to the inside of lid edge

11. Put glue on the map/ cardboard and carefully push in place to the inside top of lid
12. Repeat with the felt cardboard to bottom of case
13. Etch glass for frame to say: I HEART U
14. Paint frame, make clay detail, glue
15. Assemble frame with pick of bride and groom
16. Use foam mounting tape to place photo frame to right side of map
17. Cut out felt banner, fold over edge, sew to make casing
18. Die cut felt with Heat N Bond on back of felt, heat set to banner
19. String banner together, tie to outside of case.
20. Perfect gift for a bridal shower and a great keepsake to keep all the wedding cards in!
